ITEMS WE CANNOT ACCEPT:

- Anything broken or damaged
- Anything with mold rot, bed bugs, or containing evidence of mouse or rat droppings, due to the potential health hazard to our employees and volunteers
- Blinds or window treatments of any kind
- Can lights
- Ceiling tiles
- CFL bulbs
- Clothing, linens, bedding and drapes
- Computers or computer equipment (scanners, keyboards, monitors, etc)
- Corner Tubs
- Disassembled particle board furniture
- Drinking fountains
- Electronics – computers, printers, stereo equipment
- Fluorescent light tubes
- Fuel cans
- Furnaces & hot water heaters
- Hazardous chemicals
- Hollow core doors
- Light bulbs, especially fluorescent or CFL
- Lumber & trim under 6ft long, or with nails or staples

- Mattresses or box springs
- Musical instruments
- Nails and screws in coffee cans or anything besides original packaging
- Opened paint, stain, thinners or hazardous material of any kind
- Paint – oil based or latex from individuals
- Paint thinner & other hazardous or toxic chemicals or pesticides
- Pesticides or hazardous materials
- Rusted or painted hardware—screws, nails, washers, bolts, etc.
- Shower doors
- Single pane windows
- Sleeper sofas
- Small appliances
- Toys, clothes, baby items
- Trim or lumber less than 6 ft. long
- Tubs -Corner, Garden, or Oversize
- TV's or computers
- Unbagged insulation
- Unframed mirrors or glass
- Urinals or wall mounted toilets
- Used blinds
- Used carpet or used carpet pad
- Used cast iron sinks
- Used dishwashers
- Used water heaters
- Valances
- Water softeners
- Window parts and pieces
